mains to be seen if this does or doesn't amount to a hill of decaying beans but uncertainties surrounding Hughes Energy and their industry track record are raising tough questions.

Hughes Energy is trying to bring what they say is an environmentally evolved, steam-based, waste treatment plant to communities of Prattsville and Grand Gorge, the latter in the town of Roxbury. From the beginning of

what is now a nearly 2year permitting process involving the Department of Environmental Con-servation and other oversight agencies, Hughes Energy has stated it has a history of successful operations in Europe and the United Kingdom.

At no point, however, have they shared phone numbers or emails of those operations so this newspaper could follow up on their claims.

It is very relevant. Hearing first-hand from those overseas opera-tions might allay worries being expressed by many folks in Prattsville, Grand Gorge and beyond about the impact the huge plant will have on everyday

life.

I cleverly (or not) referred to them as the Trash Spies, noting they have reached out to people in Ireland, getting information they say is oddly unsettling, at best, and, at worst, worthy of raising serious red flags. One official in Limer-

ick. Ireland, answering inquiries from the Trash Spies, had this to say about an operation that Hughes Energy was sup-posedly touting as proof their system is world-al-tering and trustworthy.

your questions: "Wilson Biochemical is the inventor of the [au-toclave] Wilson System and has deployed the technology commercially

5 times since 1998. "Every system which has been deployed has been sold to third party private customers

"The plant in Limerick was owned and operated by a private company with no affiliation to Hughes Energy. "The plant in Limerick

operated much longer than is stated [by the official]. I cannot speak for others as to why there

is a discrepancy.

"One thing to keep in mind is that the plant started operation circa 2007, which is quite some time ago. Also, keep in mind that the business was run by a private company, not the local government.

"The Wilson Biochemical plant in York is a unit which is used to conduct projects for customers of various organic waste inputs and to cre-ate fiber for customer-led projects," McSpedon

"Currently, Wilson is part of a team of compa-nies, including Rolls nies, including Rolls Royce, contracted to create high value Aviation Fuel as part of the Sustainable Aviation Fuel project.

"There are also projects ongoing to produce nextgeneration battery tech-nology using citric acid and recycling banknotes for Central Banks.

"Hughes and Wilson Biochemical is operating under strict NDAs [non-disclosure agreements] from our customers which does not allow for release of information related to their proprietary
